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1.Introduction

1.1.General data

Educational program 6B01301 Pedagogy and methodology of elementary education, implemented State University named after Shakarim of Semey city, in the faculty of Humanities, Department of pedagogy tailored to the needs of the regional labour market, the requirements of the normative documents of the Ministry of education and science of the Republic of Kazakhstan and is a system of documents for organization of educational process.

The uniqueness of the educational program 6B01301 Pedagogy and methodology of primary education consists in the multidisciplinary approach that combines diagnostic, organizational and technological, managerial and pedagogical, project, research activities aimed at forming the professional activity of a teacher in the field of education and science.

Much attention in the organization of the educational program is paid to practice-oriented learning technologies that allow competently organizing the process of updating the content of education in the Republic of Kazakhstan. The educational program is focused not only on the transfer of a system of theoretical knowledge, but, first of all, on the ability to apply this knowledge to solve real problems, i.e., on the formation of a basic level of professional competencies.

Graduates of the educational program 6B01301 Pedagogy and methodology of primary education have the opportunity to carry out professional activities in a wide area of the education system. A special role in the educational program is given to the formation of students ` professional competencies. Formed competencies enable them to carry out activities in the management system education: IU- modesty educational organizations (secondary schools, colleges), experts from training institutes, specialists of departments of education, teachers of ungraded schools, etc., and also to carry out the pedagogical process in the field of in-clusive education tailored to children with special needs.

the content of the disciplines included in the educational program 6b01301 pedagogy and methods of primary education is agreed with employers and is in demand in the market of educational services.

When implementing the educational program, it is planned to use artificial intelligence tools in the educational process, thereby developing digital competencies among students in a rapidly changing technological environment.

The educational program provides for the education of a student with special educational needs in the conditions of a higher educational institution, as well as his socialization and integration into society.

1.2.Completion criteria

The main criterion for the completion of the educational process in the preparation of bachelors is the acquisition of at least 205 credits of theoretical training, as well as at least 27 credits of practice, not 8 credits for the preparation of diplomas. Total 240 credits.

2.1 Information about the educational program

The educational program is developed in accordance with the National Qualifications Framework and Professional Standards, aligned with the Dublinand Descriptorsи and the European рамкой Qualifications Framework. The typical duration of a bachelor's degree program is 4 years.

The academic load and knowledge gained by students are necessarily monitored by the relevant structural divisions of the university. Monitoring of students ' academic achievements and assessment of their knowledge is carried out by specialists of the registrar's office and is aimed at the final result. The level of students ' knowledge is determined by the current, intermediate and final forms of control. In general, the department and faculty have created favorable academic environment, a flexible system of social supportaimed at помощь обучающимся helpingocвstudents completeoй educational programsы and realize their creative potential.

2.3 Internal and external conditions for OP development

The educational program "6B01301 - Pedagogy and methods of primary education" at the bachelor's level is provided with all the necessary material and technical resources: a sufficient classroom fund, specialized classrooms.

Educational and methodological documents include working curricula, academic calendars, a catalog of elective subjects, and a Master's manual for all disciplines. The content of the educational program provides the breadth of training of specialists in accordance with the name of the program and the depth of training of the area of the specialty being defined. The educational program is updated annually taking into account the needs of the market and employers, as well as taking into account changes in state standards and regulatory documents the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kazakhstan. The educational program is discussed at a meeting of the department, at a meeting of the Academic Committee, to which employers and students are invited, and then approved by the Academic

Council of the University. Educational and methodical complexes of educational programs and educational and methodical complexes of disciplines of university and elective components are formed and constantly improved at the department. UMKD is compiled in accordance with the State Educational Standard of the Republic of Kazakhstan, working curricula and reflect the main content of the discipline taught. All components of the UMCD are subject to the cathedral expertise and are approved by the Faculty's Quality Assurance Commission.

Outsourcing activities of the specialty "6B01301-Pedagogy and methods of primary education" are carried out by conducting industrial, pedagogical, research practices, this activity is carried out by practice bases, in particular general education schools in Semey: N \otimes 8, N \otimes 16, N \otimes 30, N \otimes 44 N \otimes 37, N \otimes 39. The main requirements for partners are to improve the quality of practical training of future specialists, familiarize them with the conduct of scientific research, methodological work. These requirements are set out in bilateral agreements with these organizations. The results of the internship are reflected in student reports. All types of practices implemented within the framework of the EP are carried out in accordance with the end-to-end internship program, academic calendar, contracts with practice bases, as well as on the basis of P 042-1.01-2022 "Regulations on professional practice and the definition of organizations as practice bases for bachelor's and higher special education" and the order of the university rector.

The main indicator of achieving the goal of the OP "6B01301 - Pedagogy and methods of primary education" is the indicators of employment of graduates in the first year after graduation. The average employment rate of graduates studying under a state grant for 3 years is 100%.

The OP management systematically works to inform all stakeholders about the results of implementing the quality assurance policy. All stakeholders are informed about the results of the implementation of the quality assurance policy during open days, when the educational program is presented to potential applicants and their parents, meetings of applicants with students and graduates of the university are organized, and information booklets are issued during career guidance and information work with parents and schoolchildren of the region.

Awareness of internal and external consumers of educational services about the activities of the department and students of the OP is provided by placing basic documents on information stands, the official website of the University, in the media, social networks (Facebook, Instagram).

To develop a plan for the development of the educational program of the specialty "6B01301 - Pedagogy and methods of primary education", leading teachers of departments, representatives from among students, representatives of employers are involved. To inform all interested parties, on the website <u>www.semgu.kz</u> of the university contains an approved plan for the development of educational programs, academicucalendars and a listeofь elective subjects. At the end of the academic year, at a

meeting of the department with the participation of all interested parties (teaching staff, employers), a self-assessment of the EP is conducted, taking into account the changes made, the results achieved, the effectiveness and effectiveness of the implementation of the EP are discussed.

The individuality and prospects of the development planoй of the educational program of the OP specialty "6B01301-Pedagogy and methods of primary education" are characterized by the uniqueness of the NAO "Shakarim University of Semey" as a regional multidisciplinary university and as a university that trains specialists in the field of "Education". Also, the competitive advantages of the University are the possibility of continuing their studies in the Master's and PhD doctoralprograms.

OP "6B01301-Pedagogy and methods of primary education" is carried out in the academic building on 159/3 Shugaeva Street/3. The Department of "Pedagogy" is located on the 2nd floor. For the preparation of bachelor's and master's students, the department has modern teaching and laboratory rooms, technical training facilities, visual and demonstration materials. The number of classrooms fully covers the entire student population and ensures continuity in accordance with the schedule of the educational process. All computers with Internet access.

Teaching staff of the department conduct classes in bright, well-lit classrooms. Practical classes in a number of core disciplines are held in specialized classrooms equipped with 10 PCs, an electronic whiteboard, and training stands. The teaching department has 2 computers, 2 printers, 2 scanners, has access to the Internet, to the educational portal https://ais.semgu.kz/login.php and the website of the NAO "Shakarim Semey University". Provisionoй of educational programsы with educational and methodical complexes of disciplines is 100%. Acquisition of new educational and scientific literature in accordance with the specialty is carried out annually. The Graduate Department of "IIPsychagogics" has its own page on the university's website https://shakarim.edu.kz

Educational and methodological documents of the educational program are developed in accordance with the existing regulatory documents:

- State mandatory standard of Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan;
- Catalog of elective subjects;
- Working curriculum;
- Educational and methodical complexes of disciplines for all learning paths.

Teachers of the department conduct lectures in on-line and off - line mode according to the schedule of classes of students of the Faculty of Distance Learning line . Special attention is paid to improving the skills of teachers by passing advanced training courses and scientific internships in domestic and foreign universities, enterprises and organizations.

The most common innovative methods developed by teaching staff of departments for lecturing, conducting practical and laboratory classes include: webinars, trainings, video lectures, presentations, working with an interactive whiteboard, using software (ORIGIN, CHEMOFFICE, Activ Inspire, Freemake Video Converter, Quiz Maker, Kahoot).

The portal of educational resources of NAO "Shakarim Semey University" is functioning (http://cloud.semgu.kz/), which contains lectures, videos, hyperlinks, tasks for self-examination, presentations on topics, yue6hble textbooks, and other educational and methodical content on the subjects studied in the OP, the content of which the teaching staff applies in the classroom, and to which students have access 24-hour access. 2.4 Information about teaching staff implementing the educational program

Teachers are the main resource of the educational process. The qualifications and level of teaching of teachers working in this educational program meet all the requirements.

The teaching staff that implements the educational program is fully formed. The personnel policy of the Faculty of Humanities and Economics and the Department of Pedagogyegarorики"is an integral element of the personnel management of NAO "Shakarim University of Semey", which is based on a reasonable combination of democratization and centralization of

human resources management functions. The development of human resources is a priority area in the university's activities and the main condition for successfully solving the tasks of educational and research activities.

The main tasks of the personnel policy are the selection of personnel of the required professions, specialties and qualifications, improving the average level of settling down, teaching staff, advanced training and professional retraining of teaching staff and university employees, reducing staff turnover, introducing modern methods of personnel management, updating the database of university personnel, its timely replenishment, prompt submission required information on demand, staff turnover analysis.

To train specialists in the OP "6B01301 - Pedagogy and methods of primary education", a highly qualified team of teachers consists of 24 people, штатных ППС including 9 full-time teaching staff. Full-time teachers include 4 candidates of pedagogical sciences, 4 master's degrees. The share of full-time teachers of the department with academic degrees is 45%. The current staff of the teaching staff has a basic education corresponding to the profile of the OP and is able to provide high-quality training of specialists at the present time. Of the total number of teachers, 92% teach classes in the state language.

The number of staff is determined in accordance with the number of disciplines, the standard of academic loads, and the number of students. The basic education of the teaching staff working under the educational program meets all the requirements.

The department carries out the educational process in two levels of study: bachelor's and master's degree. Professional development –is a type of professional training for employees. The purpose of this type of training is to increase the level of theoretical knowledge of employees, as well as to improve practical skills and abilities that increase in accordance with the requirements of state educational standards. Professional development is aimed at consistently improving professional knowledge, skills and abilities, and increasing the skill of employees in a particular specialty.

Every year, teaching staff of the department under OP 6B01301 - "Pedagogy and methods of primary education" undergo advanced training in leading universities and research centers of the Republic of Kazakhstan and abroad in the subjects taught. So teachers of the Department Ph. D. Turganbayeva B. Sh., Kanidollayeva T. A. completed a scientific internship at the Kokand University of the Republic of Uzbekistan, in the target direction Ph. D. Turganbayeva B. Sh. completed advanced training courses at the National Pedagogical University. Abaya.

The qualified staff of teachers is able to provide a high-quality educational process, meets the qualification requirements, level and specifics of the educational program. Among the teaching staff of the department, 2 are holders of the title "Best University Teacher", and practical teachers are actively involved in the educational process under the educational program.

Teachers and students of the department are actively engaged in scientific activities. The faculty publishes scientific articles not only in the journalsof COKSN HE RK and in journals with an impact factor included in the database in Web of Science and Scopus. In the future, it is planned to increase the scientific potential of the department by defending 1 PhD of the doctor.

2.5 Characteristics of the OP's achievements

Students of the educational program OP "6B01301-Pedagogy and methods of primary education" have the opportunity to acquire theoretical knowledge and practical skills, both in the course of lectures and in practical classes. Innovative and interactive forms of learning are widely used in the classroom, and students participate in research work and creative competitions in their specialty. Practitioners and foreign qualified lecturers are invited to give lectures and conduct seminars. Students participate in student projects, start-up projects and Olympiads of various levels, for example, in the Republican Research Competition of students in 2024, the work of the student V. Oleynikov took the 3rd place, 4 students entered the ranks of the "TOP 100" university students. External and internal academic mobility of teaching staff and students is actively being implemented. Teachers of the Department Ph. D. Turganbayeva B. Sh., Kanidollayeva T. A. in the current academic year passed academic mobility at the Kokand University of the Republic of Uzbekistan, students of this OP were trained in academic mobility at the Zhetysu University named after I. Zhansugurov, and students of the Amanzholov EKSU were trained in academic mobility at our university. In 2023, OP "6B01301-Pedagogy and methods of primary education" took the 1st place out of 32 educational programs presented in the Chamber of Entrepreneurs "Atameken".

3. Main objectives of the OP development Plan

Goals and objectives of the educational program "6B01301-Pedagogy and methods of primary education", taking into account the requirements and requests of potential consumers, and based on the assessment of the demand for the educational program, which are determined by the interests of potential employers, applicants, the potential of the university, the requirements of the state and society as a whole.

The main goal of the development plan of the educational program is to train highly qualified and competitive personnel in pedagogye and methods of primary education, who are proficient inx modern innovative educational technologies.

For the effective implementation of the OP, the following tasks are defined:

• Academic mobility of teaching staff and students;

- Development and implementation of scientific projects;
- * Focus the educational program on students ' research activities;
- Development of human resources;

• - Strengthening the language training of teaching staff by compulsory attendance of foreign language courses created both at the university and outside it;

The final results imply: participation in funded grant projects, publishing activity of teaching staff in rating publications with a non-zero impact factor, development and functioning of joint educational programs with foreign universities, implementation of research results in the educational process, involvement of undergraduates in research, academic mobility of students and teaching staff.
